### For Broadcom/VMware by Broadcom Employees

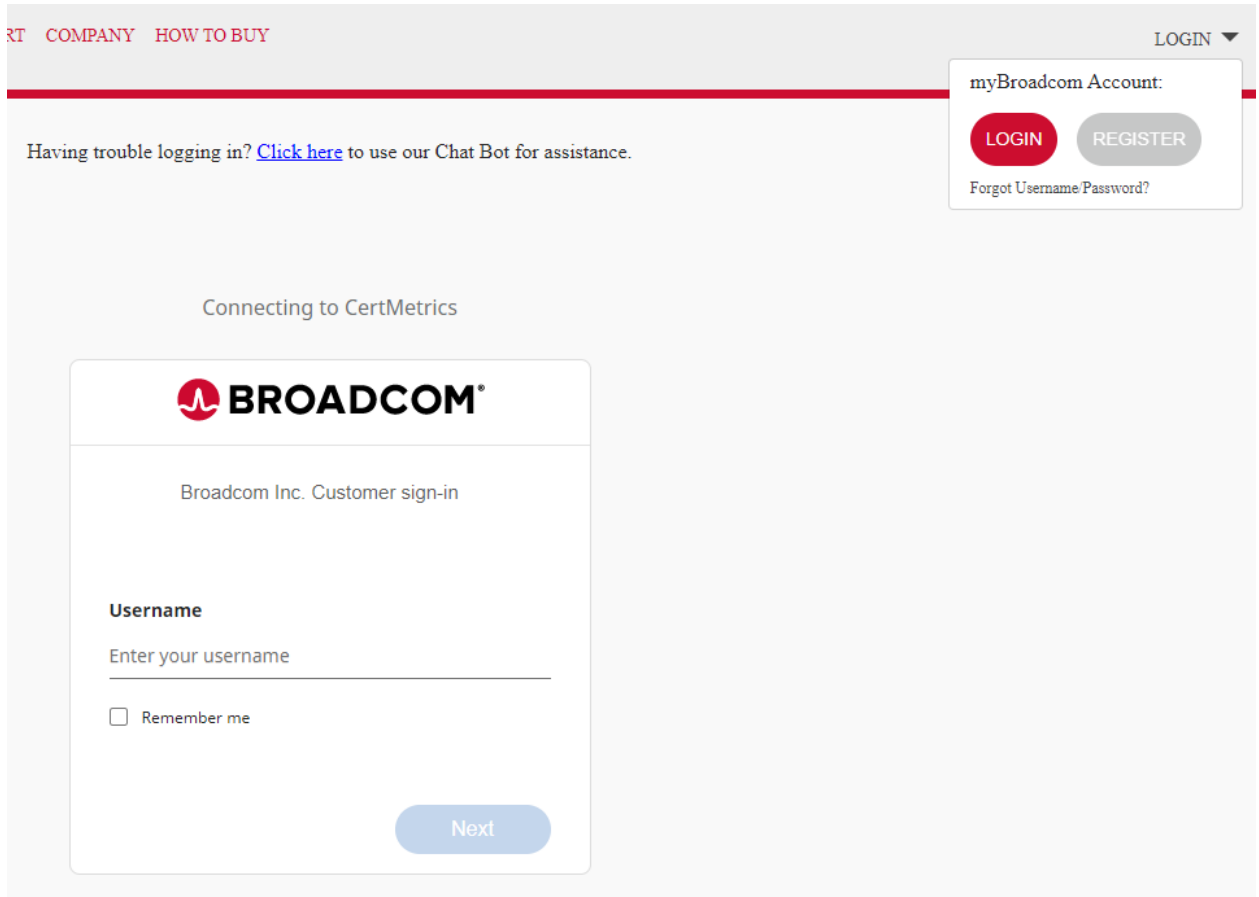

2. If you have never had a Broadcom account, select the 'Login' drop down from the top-right and click the 'Register' button.



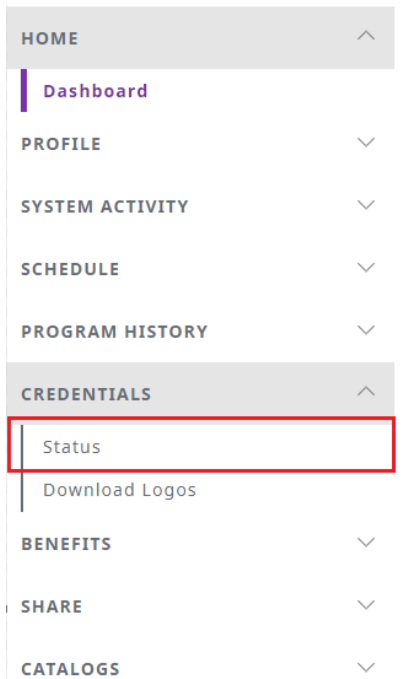

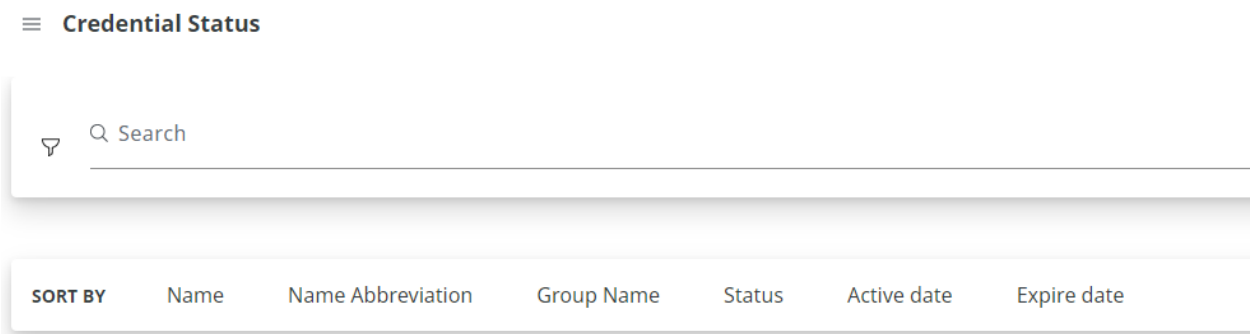

## Find all credentials earned

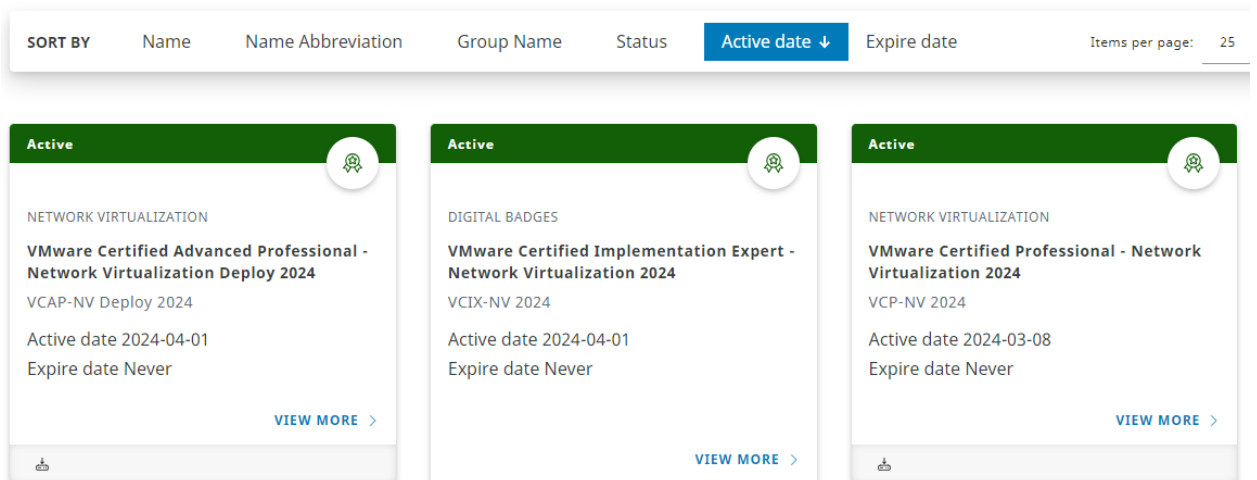
1. Select 'Credentials' from the left-hand menu. Click 'Status'



2. You can use filters to find the relevant credential.

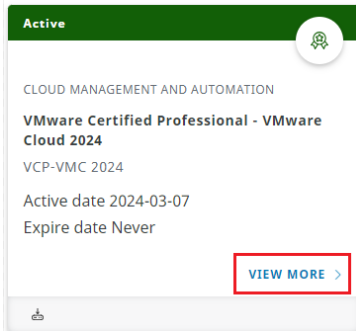


3. See everything earned.

5. For completed credentials, you can see the details of which requirements were used to earn it. Select 'View more'.

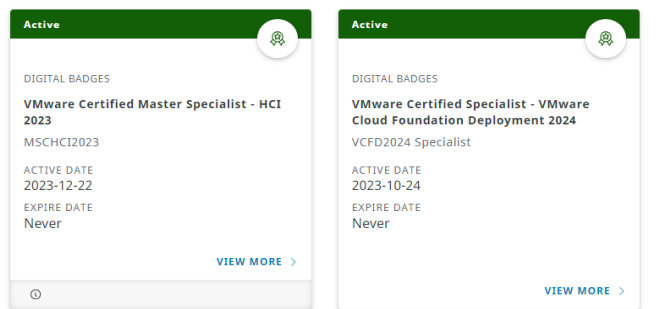


6. Scroll down to see items highlighted in green bold.

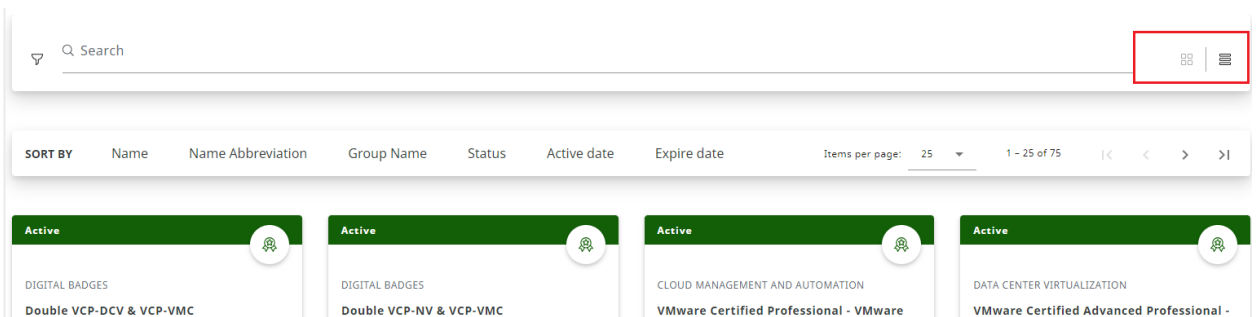



## Change to list view

2. You can change with the selection to the right of the 'Search' bar. Select the horizontal lines to change to 'List View.'



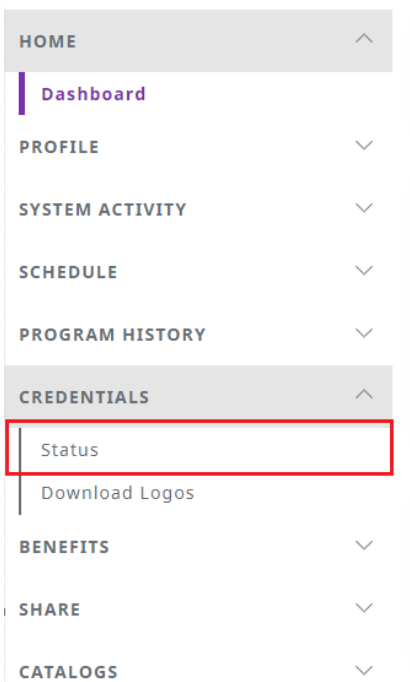

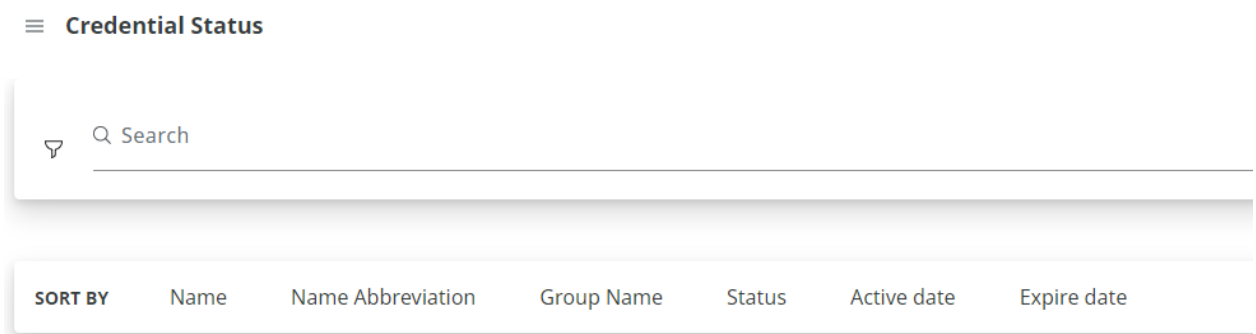

1. Select 'Credentials' from the left-hand menu. Click 'Status'

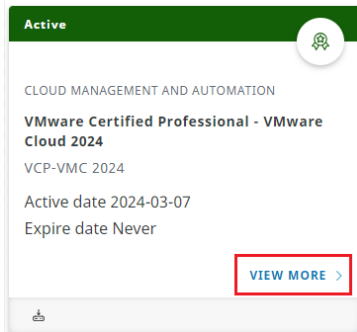


2. You can use filters to find the relevant credential

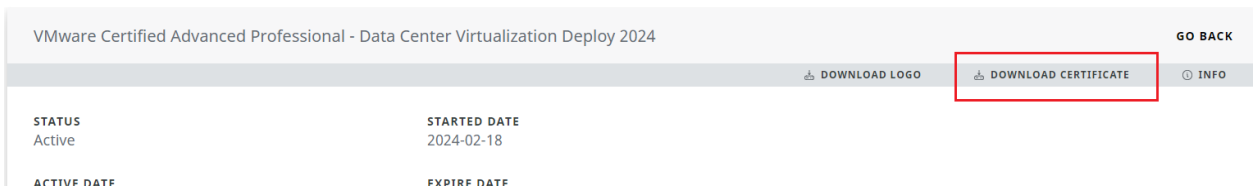


3. For any earned certification, select "View more >"

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4. In the upper right of screen, select “Download Certificate”

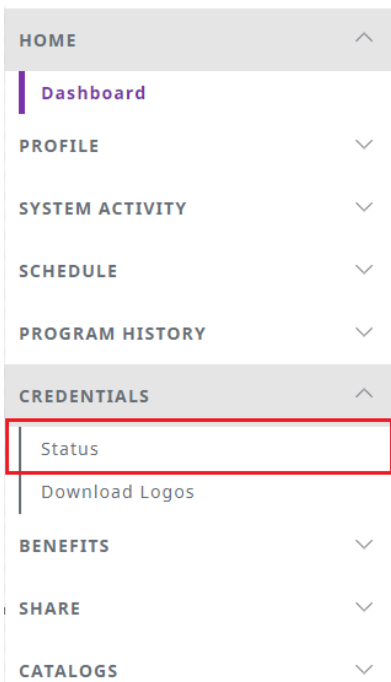


## How to find your logos

There are two ways to download logos.

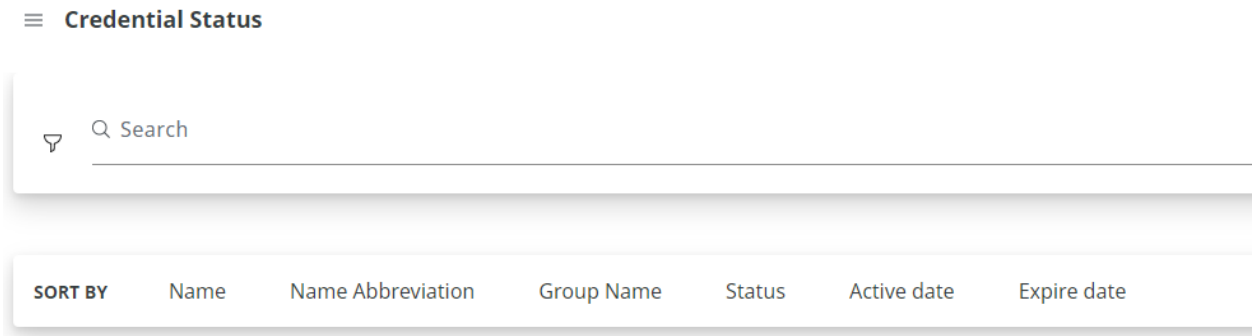
### OPTION 1

1. Select 'Credentials' from the left-hand menu. Click 'Status'

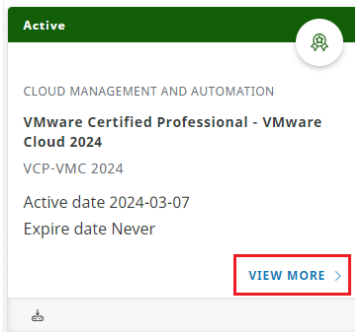


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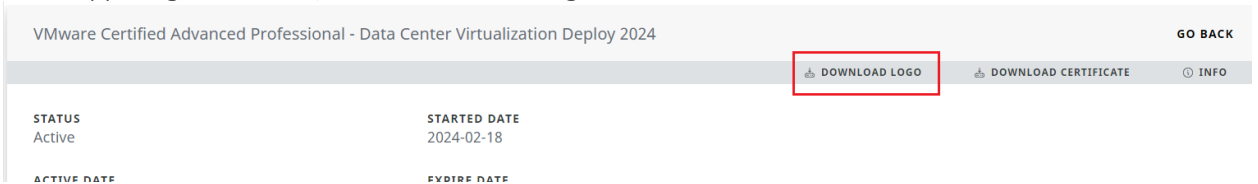
2. You can use filters to find the relevant credential.



3. For any earned certification, select 'View more >'



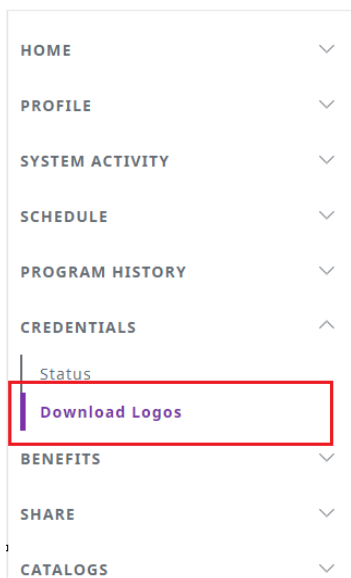
4. In the upper right of screen, select "Download Logo"



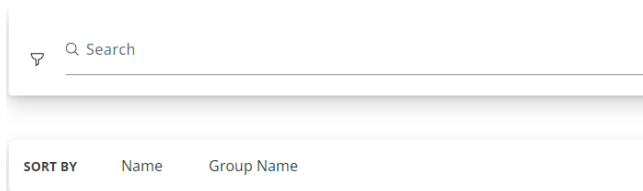
## OPTION 2

1. Select 'Credentials' from the left-hand menu. Click 'Download Logos'

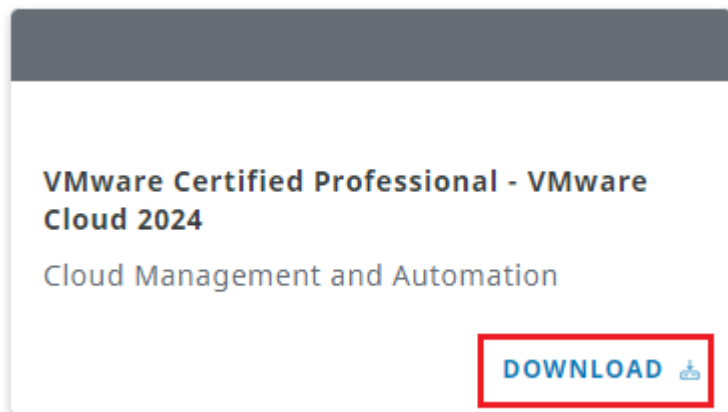




2. Use the search and filter functions to find your earned credential

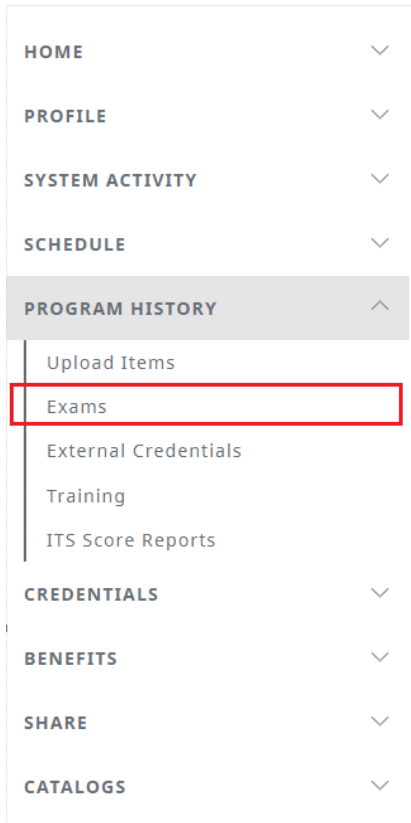


3. Select the 'Download' button on the credential card.

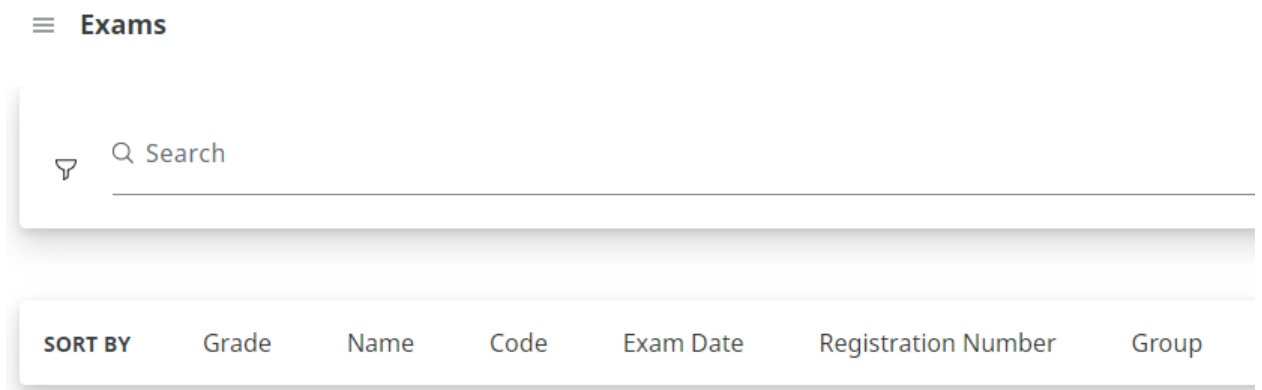


## How to find my exam history

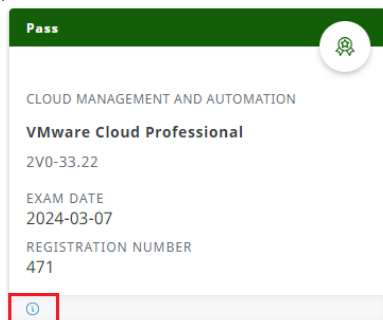
1. From the left-hand menu, select 'Program History' then 'Exams'



2. Use the search or filter functions to find the relevant exam

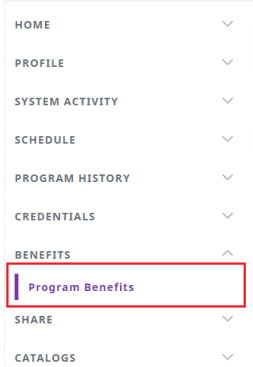


3. View the basic details of the exam attempt. You can also select the 'Information' icon to view the web site related to the exam.

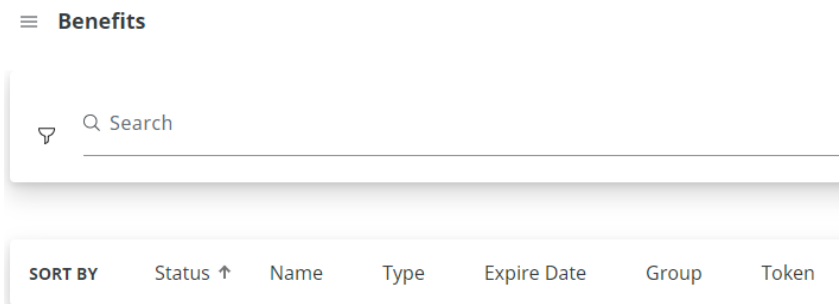


## View your certification benefits

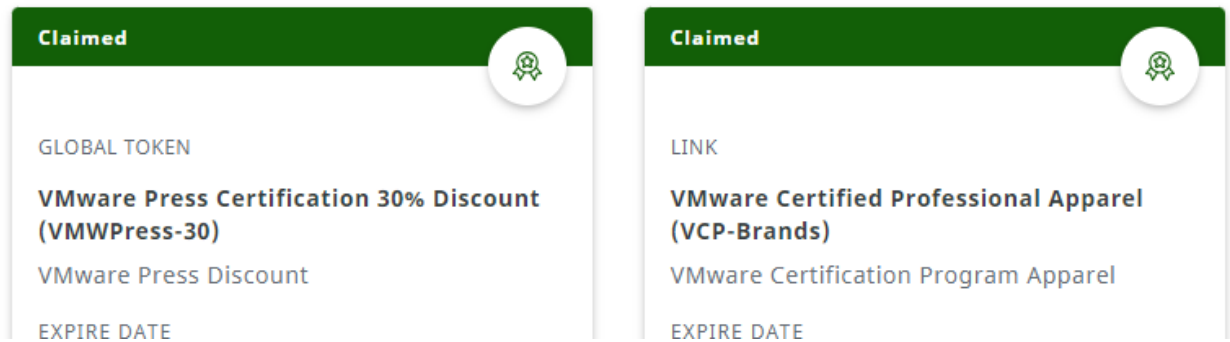
1. Select from the left-hand menu 'Benefits' then 'Program Benefits'.



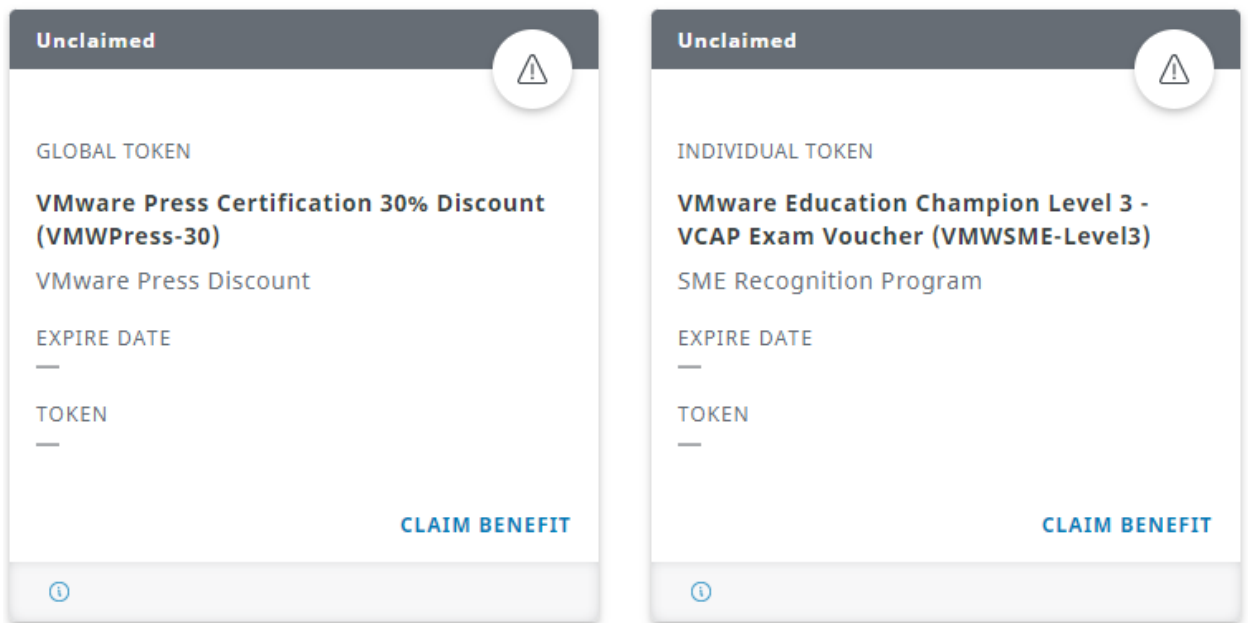
2. Use the search and filter functions to find the benefit.



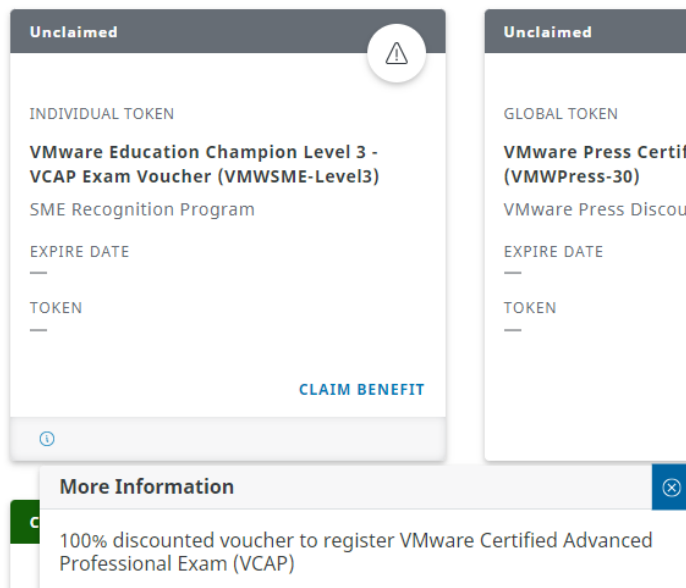
3. You can quickly see if you have already claimed your benefit via the green heading and the text 'Claimed.'



4. If you have not claimed your benefit, select the 'Claim Benefit' link to connect to the benefits.

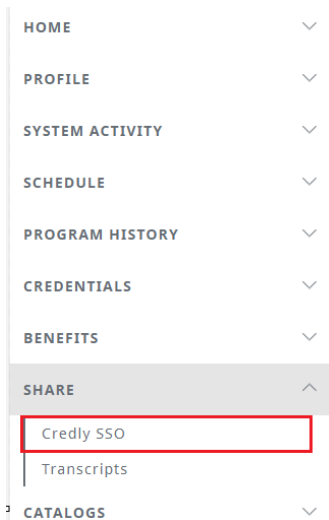


5. You can also select the 'Information' icon to read more about the benefit.

2. Once logged into the digital badge provider (Credly), you will be able to access your proof of achievement.

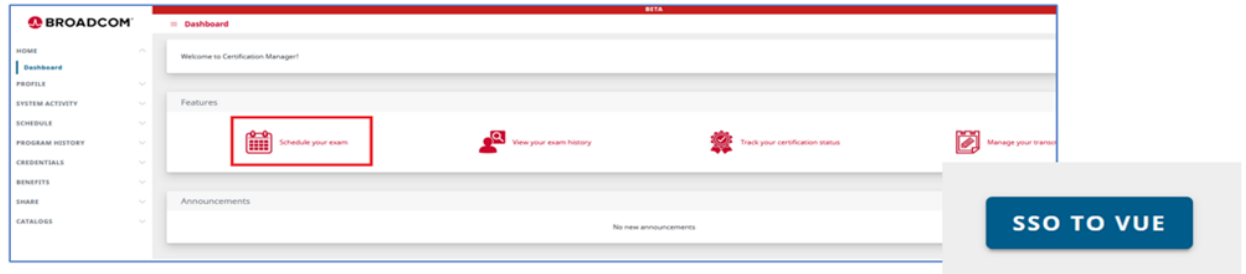

3. This will redirect you to the Credly site to see all the digital badges you have earned.

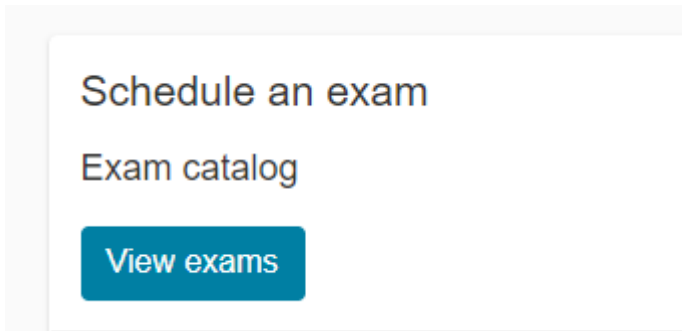
## How to review the entire exam catalog
