Overview

[VMware Horizon®](#) enables the efficient delivery of virtual desktops and applications across on-premises and multi-cloud infrastructure, providing employees secure access to corporate resources anywhere, anytime, on any device. Leveraging deep integration with the VMware technology ecosystem, Horizon offers an agile cloud-ready foundation, modern best-in-class hybrid cloud management, and end-to-end security that empowers today's distributed workforce with the [VMware Anywhere Workspace](#). This white paper covers packaging and licensing of the VMware Horizon product family, including Horizon editions and related products. Pricing information is accessible through the VMware or VMware partner price lists, or through your local VMware representative.

This guide is intended as an overview to understand the Horizon product portfolio and corresponding SKUs. This guide is not intended to replace or contradict the VMware [product end-user license agreement \(EULA\)](#) or VMware price lists. Information in this guide is also subject to change and will be updated accordingly.

General purchasing and support information

VMware Horizon and related products can be purchased through VMware distributors and partners, or through VMware directly.

VMware Horizon is available in a subscription licensing model with two options: Subscription SaaS and Term. Horizon Subscription SaaS and Term offerings include Production Support and Subscription (SnS). Production SnS entitles customers to VMware support 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Any available perpetual offerings related to Horizon (listed in the [Related product details section](#)) must be purchased in conjunction with SnS. For perpetual offerings, SnS is available in Basic and Production options. Both support options entitle customers to all product updates and upgrades. For support details, access the [Basic](#) and [Production](#) web pages.

Edition feature comparisons and upgrade tool

Horizon Subscription SaaS and Term options have the following requirements and available editions.

Horizon SaaS licenses require connecting your Horizon deployment (whether on premises or in the cloud) to the cloud-hosted Horizon Control Plane and are available in the following editions: Horizon Apps Standard Subscription, Horizon Apps Universal Subscription, Horizon Standard Plus Subscription, Horizon Enterprise Plus Subscription, and Horizon Universal Subscription.

Horizon SaaS licenses have a core model. You must purchase a single core SKU, which will automatically create a new service ID (SID) that identifies a subscription instance for Horizon offers. Then, you should purchase the balance of seats needed using add-on to core SKUs. For example, if you want to buy 1,000 Horizon Universal Subscription seats:

- Buy 1 core SKU, which is available to start at 50 seats.
- Buy 95 add-on to core SKUs, which are available in 10 seats each (giving a total of 950 add-on seats), for a total of 1,000 seats that include the 1 core SKU seats.

Horizon Term licenses do not require connecting to the cloud-hosted Horizon Control Plane and are available in the following editions: Horizon Apps Standard Term, Horizon Apps Advanced Term, Horizon Standard Term, Horizon Advanced Term, and Horizon Enterprise Term.

Deployment options and management responsibilities

Horizon SaaS editions offer options for if you want or need your desktops and data to be hosted on a VMware software-defined data center (SDDC) (on premises or on VMware Cloud™ platforms) or natively in the cloud, such as Microsoft Azure or AWS. Table 1 shows the available deployment options and management responsibilities of each deployment type. For example, with Horizon on premises, you have the responsibility to manage each layer of your virtual desktop infrastructure (VDI)/desktop-as-a-service (DaaS) deployment. With VMware Horizon Cloud Service™ on Microsoft Azure, you only have the responsibility to manage desktops and apps, leaving the infrastructure layers managed by VMware and Microsoft.

Horizon Universal Subscription and Horizon Apps Universal Subscription entitle you to all deployment options.

Horizon Standard Plus Subscription, Horizon Enterprise Plus Subscription, and Horizon Apps Standard Subscription entitle you to any single cloud deployment option, but you can't deploy on Horizon Cloud Service on Microsoft Azure.

Horizon Term licenses can only be deployed on premises.

Horizon licensing model

Horizon is available on a per-named-user or a per-concurrent-connection model:

- Per named user (NU) – For virtual environments with staff that require dedicated access to a virtual machine (VM) throughout the day. For example, Organization A has 10 employees who will all be working simultaneously, needing access at the same time. In this scenario, Organization A will need 10 NU licenses.
- Per concurrent connection (CCU) – For virtual environments with a high number of users who share machines throughout the day, such as students and shift workers. A concurrent connection is defined as the total number of users accessing or using the software at any given time to maintain an active connection to their workspace or desktop through an endpoint device. For example, Organization B has 10 employees, but 5 employees work during the day and 5 employees work during the evening. As only 5 employees will need access at a time, Organization B will be better suited for 5 CCU licenses rather than 10 NU licenses.

In both NU and CCU metrics, the components of a Horizon bundle cannot be split among users. This applies to both named and concurrent connection instances. Although a bundle has individual components, the components together should be thought of as a single product. In this manner, even if an end user in a concurrent connection scenario is only connected to Horizon, the other associated components of the bundle (e.g., VMware Workspace ONE® Access™) are also considered to be attached to that user and not available to be entitled to other users.

For example, Organization A has 100 concurrent-connection licenses of Horizon Universal Subscription. User A connects to their virtual desktop and consumes 1 concurrent connection. However, User A is not using VMware ThinApp®. Does this free up ThinApp for another user, given that User A is not active on ThinApp? The answer is no. Even if User A is not connected to all of the components in the bundle, once they connect to any one of the components in the bundle, the others by default become attached to that user for as long as they are connected to their session.

When to use NU or CCU

If the primary use case is around Horizon desktops and you have end users accessing their desktops in shifts (e.g., 300 in the morning and 200 in the evening, but never all 500 at the same time), then you should buy 300 CCU licenses of Horizon.

If the primary use case is around Horizon desktops and you do not have shift workers (e.g., all 500 employees are always connected at the same time), then you should buy NU licenses.

Note: If the primary use case is around Horizon desktops for kiosks, you should buy CCU licenses.

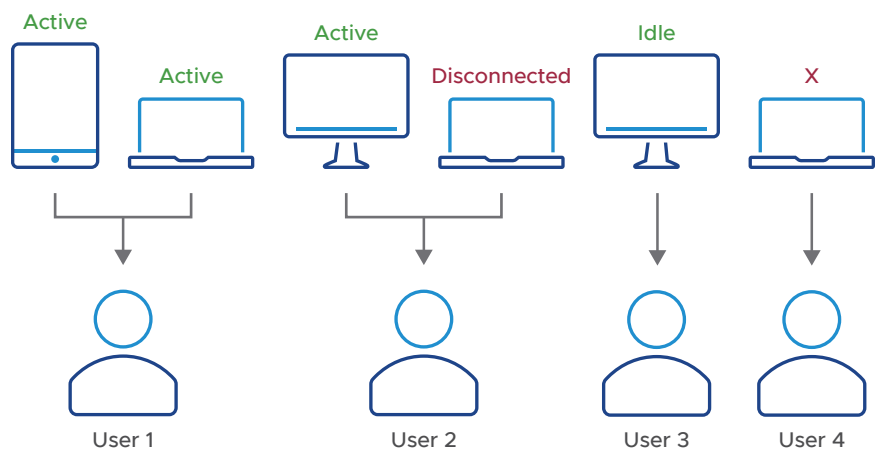


Figure 1: Four employees at Widget-A, Inc.

In another CCU example, Figure 1 shows Widget-A, Inc, which bought 4 CCU licenses for their employees. That means their license count is 4 concurrent connections. User 1 takes 2 CCU licenses connecting from 2 devices. User 2 takes up 1 CCU license because they have 1 active session. User 3 takes 1 CCU license for an idle session. Technically, User 4 cannot connect because all 4 CCU licenses are already used by Users 1–3.

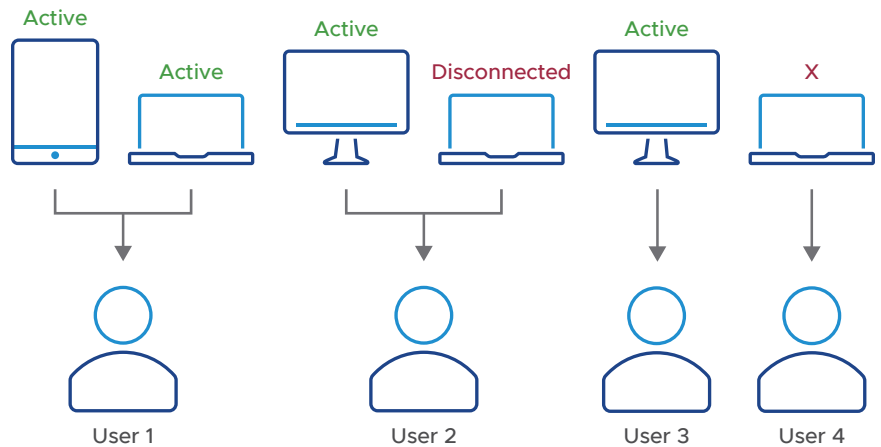


Figure 2: Four users at Widget-B, Inc.

In another NU example, Figure 2 shows Widget-B, Inc., which bought 3 NU licenses and assigned them to Users 1–3. That means their license count is 3 named users. Technically, User 4 cannot connect to Horizon because they have not been assigned an NU license.

Reassigning NU licenses

In named-user licensing, the license is consumed for 60 days after the last connection was made. However, as an exception, if the employee consuming the NU license has their employment terminated with the company, the license would be available for reassignment immediately following the termination.

Mixing licenses

Mixing NU and CCU bundles under the same instance of Horizon

Mixing NU and CCU bundles in the same Horizon instance is permitted but not recommended. While not restricted within the EULA, there is no mechanism to monitor which licenses are NU and which are CCU once they are activated.

For Subscription SaaS, NU and CCU cannot be mixed within the same SID. NU and CCU need to be under different SIDs. However, more than one SID can be attached to one Horizon Control Plane, but the SIDs cannot be mixed in the same Horizon pod.

You must ensure you are in compliance at all times.

Mixing Horizon editions under the same instance of Horizon

Mixing different Horizon Term editions in the same Horizon instance is permitted but not recommended. While not restricted within the EULA, there is no mechanism to monitor which features in each edition are in use by which users.

Mixing different Horizon SaaS editions in the same Horizon instance is permitted, depending on the editions, but not recommended. While not restricted within the EULA, there is no mechanism to monitor which features in each edition are in use by which users.

You can mix and match Horizon Universal Subscription, Horizon Apps Standard Subscription, and Horizon Apps Universal Subscription licenses. You can mix and match Horizon Standard Plus Subscription and Horizon Enterprise Plus Subscription licenses. These licenses, with different terms and entitlements with different SIDs, may be mixed and run from a single environment.

Horizon Standard Plus Subscription or Horizon Enterprise Plus Subscription licenses can't mix with any other Horizon SaaS edition (e.g., Horizon Universal Subscription) on the same SID. This is not possible as it would require two control planes/pods.

This white paper does not cover mixing scenarios with perpetual editions. Please consult your local VMware representative for assistance if you require help in mixing perpetual with SaaS and Term editions.

To report usage and enforce compliance, vSphere Desktop counts powered-on desktop VMs. In the case of vSphere Desktop as a component of a full edition of Horizon, the VM serves as a proxy for the user. In a Horizon environment, the users accessing the environment are not always accurately represented by the total counts of VMs. In this case, the administrator needs to keep track of total desktop and infrastructure VMs and ensure they are in compliance.

In Citrix Virtual Apps and Desktops environments, you can use vSphere Desktop to power virtual desktops and the underlying VDI infrastructure as previously mentioned. In this use case, the VMs used to host the underlying infrastructure will count against your total powered-on VM count. For example, if your Citrix environment has a 100 pack of vSphere Desktop and you are using it to host 90 virtual desktops and 10 VMs that host the VDI environment, you have used up all the licenses for vSphere Desktop in that environment.

If you purchased a SaaS version of Horizon (for example, Horizon Universal Subscription), an initial minimum of two VMware Aria Universal Suite Standard Add-on for Horizon packs is required to meet the minimum 50 CCUs of Horizon SaaS core SKUs.
