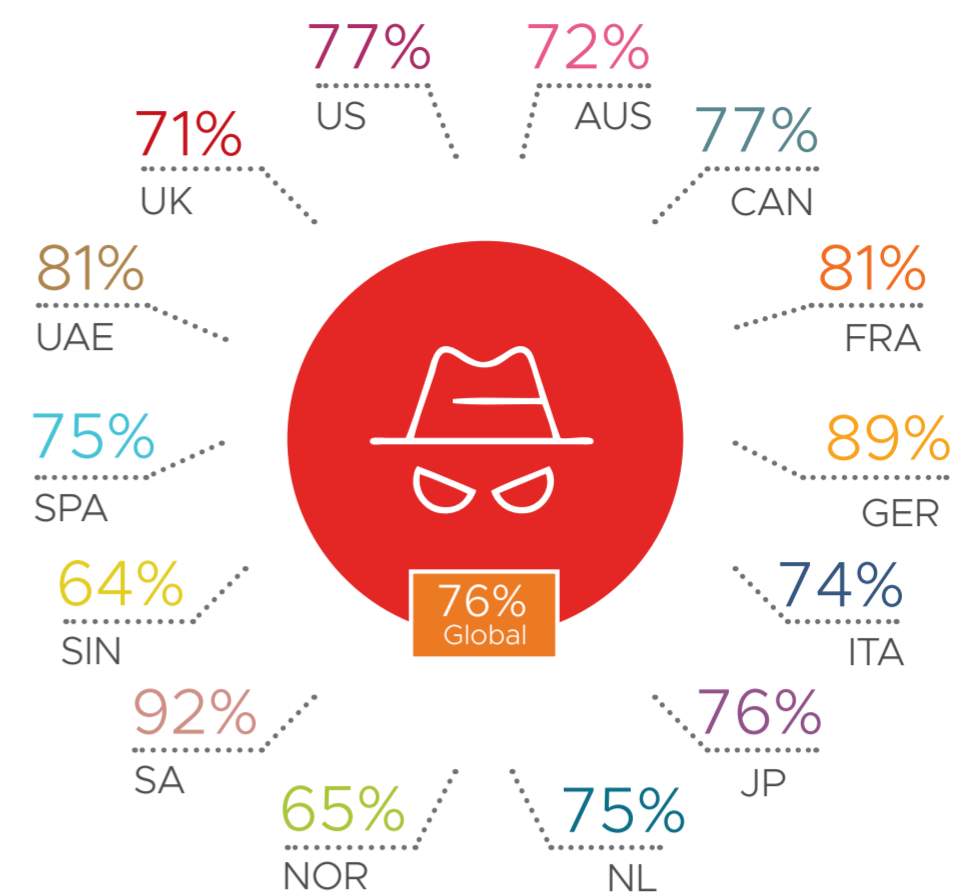

Increase in cyberattacks in the past 12 months

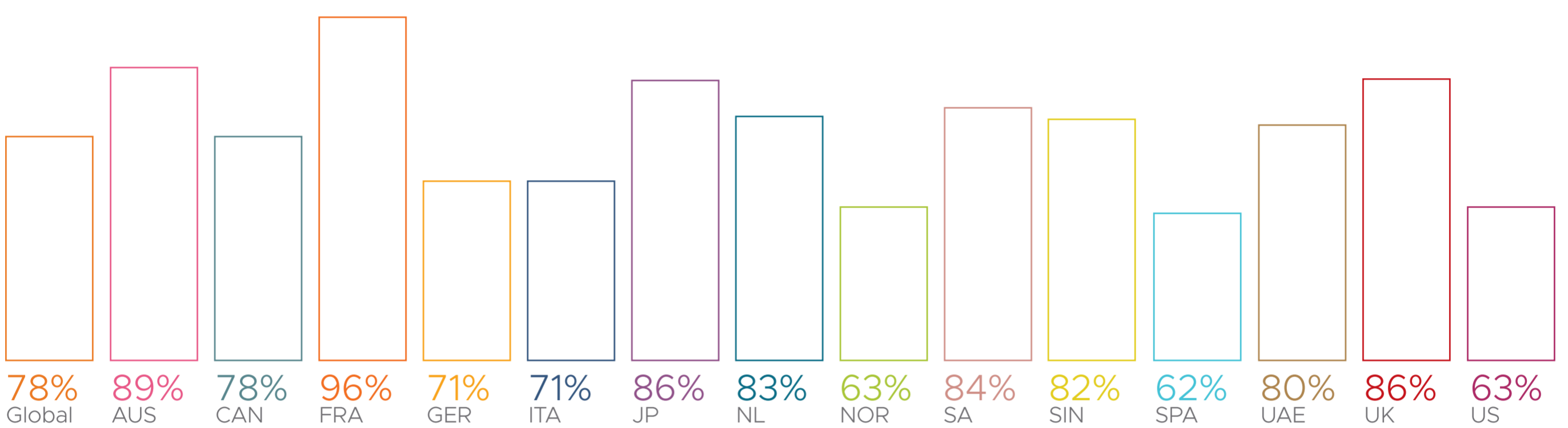

Saudi Arabia (92 percent) and Germany (89 percent) had the highest percentage of respondents reporting an increase in cyberattacks.



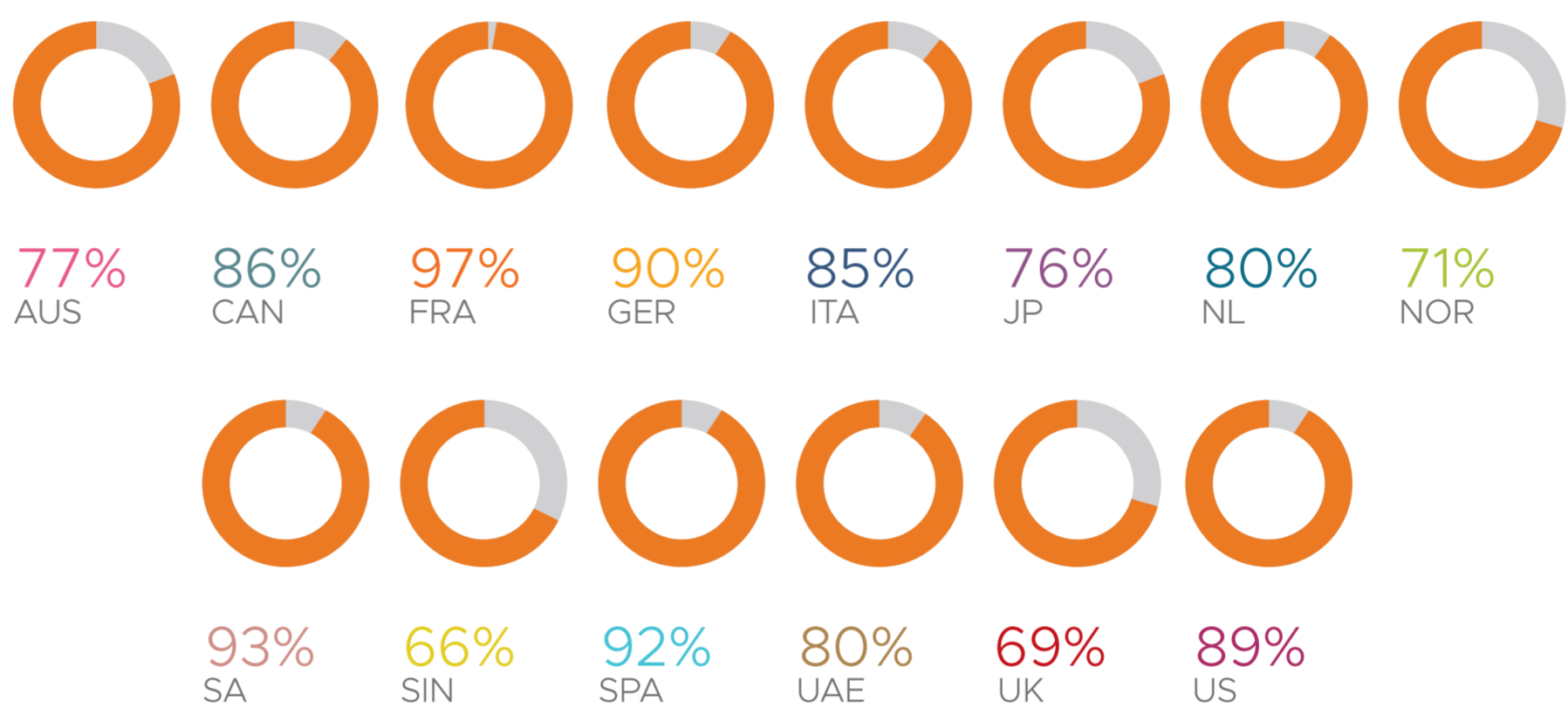
## Increase in cyberattacks as a result of working remotely

Working remotely has expanded the attack surface with respondents from France (96 percent) reporting the highest increase in cyberattacks as a result, followed by Australia (89 percent).



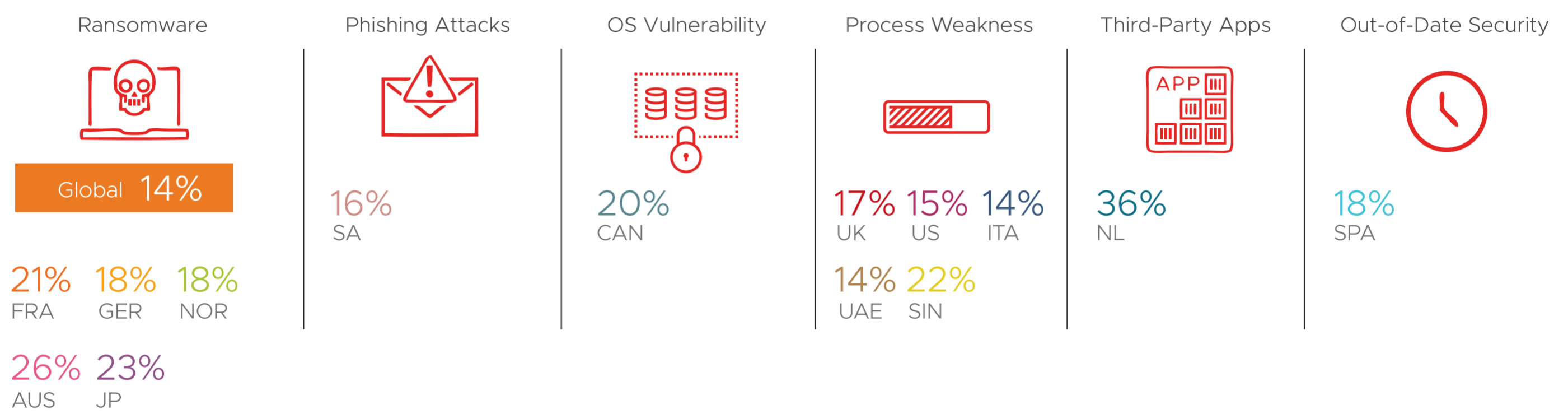
## Frequency of breaches in the past 12 months

France (97 percent) experienced the highest number of breaches, followed by Saudi Arabia (93 percent).



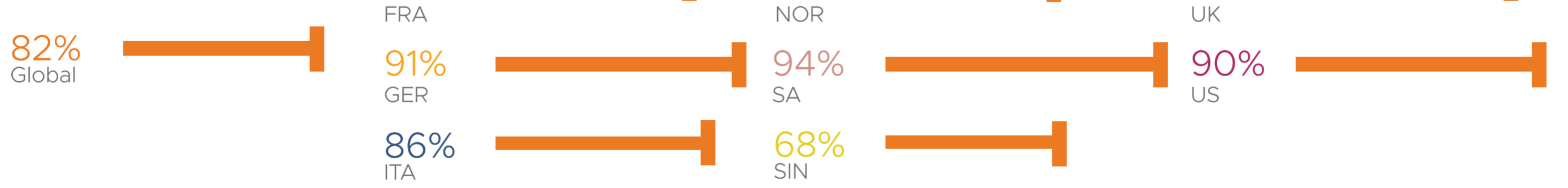
## Prime cause of breaches
