

Increase in cyberattacks in the past 12 months


Saudi Arabia (92 percent) and Germany (89 percent) had the highest percentage of respondents reporting an increase in cyberattacks.





Increase in cyberattacks as a result of working remotely


Working remotely has expanded the attack surface with respondents from France (96 percent) reporting the highest increase in cyberattacks as a result, followed by Australia (89 percent).






Frequency of breaches in the past 12 months



Fearful of a material breach in the next 12 months


































