Q. What is Google Cloud VMware® Engine (GCVE)?

A. Google Cloud VMware Engine delivers a Google-managed service for running VMware workloads in Google Cloud, with unique capabilities such as four 9s cluster-level uptime, deeply integrated networking, and a unified Google experience along with the ability to leverage Google Cloud services across AI/, ML, data analytics, security and more. The service includes VMware Cloud Foundation™, a unified, private-cloud platform with integrated, enterprise-class compute, storage, networking, management, and security, all running on dedicated, resilient Google Cloud bare-metal infrastructure. By enabling a consistent VMware experience, the service allows customers to adopt Google Cloud rapidly, easily, and without the cost, effort, or risk of re-architecting applications or retooling operations. The service brings the best of VMware and Google Cloud together on one platform for a variety of use cases.

Q. Is Google Cloud VMware Engine continuing as a Google Cloud service?

A. Yes. Google Cloud and Broadcom remain committed to the growth and enhancement of Google Cloud VMware Engine and to supporting our customers.

Q. What is the status of the Broadcom / Google Cloud partnership?

A. Broadcom and Google have a strategic partnership that spans multiple entities and product offerings. The recent License Portability capability strengthens that partnership by providing

more options to customers to flexibly use VMware Cloud Foundation subscriptions.

Q. Where can customers purchase Google Cloud VMware Engine?

A. Customers can purchase Google Cloud VMware Engine directly from Google Cloud and Google Cloud partners. Q. What is VMware Cloud Foundation license portability to Google Cloud VMware Engine?

A. Google Cloud [supports](#) VMware Cloud Foundation license portability to Google Cloud VMware Engine. Customers can purchase subscriptions of the new VMware Cloud Foundation software (as of December 13th, 2023 or later) from Broadcom and flexibly use those subscriptions in Google Cloud VMware Engine, as well as their own on-prem data centers. Customers retain the rights to the software subscription when deploying VMware Cloud Foundation on Google Cloud VMware Engine and have the ability to move their licenses between supported environments as desired. Customers also have the option to purchase a fully-integrated Google Cloud VMware Engine environment inclusive of VMware Cloud Foundation software directly from Google Cloud.

A. This is not planned at this time.

A. Google Cloud VMware Engine has achieved ISO/IEC [27001](#), [27017](#), [27018](#); [PCI-DSS](#); [SOC 1](#), [SOC 2](#), [SOC 3](#) compliance certifications, among others. Additionally, the Google Cloud Business Associate Agreement (BAA) also covers [Google Cloud VMware Engine](#). Furthermore, Google Cloud VMware Engine has been accepted as a [FedRAMP](#) High Ready offering. Broadcom and Google Cloud intend to continue to meet the security needs of customers with future offerings.
